Dear Parents/Carers,

We are delighted to announce that a residential visit for our Year 6 pupils has now been booked at Blue Peris Mountain Activity Centre (based in Snowdonia - North Wales).

The visit will take place on Monday 24th June 2024 until 28th June 2024; they will be able to take part in some amazing activities and even have some time to enjoy the beach. At this stage, we have yet to confirm the programme, but it is anticipated that some of these will be: coastering, sea traversing, gorge walking, mine exploration and mountain climbing.

Accommodation is in the form of dorms and all bedding will be provided.

The cost of this residential will be £323.00, which includes: indoor accommodation, all food, drinks, activities and travel to and from the centre in Wales. Initially, we are asking for a non-refundable deposit of £68, which would be due by 31st October 2023 – this deposit would secure your child a place on the trip.

Below is a payment plan to help you budget for payment of the trip. The total cost will be £323.00

The payment plan must be adhered to and once payment has been made it is non-refundable.

The Blue Peris Mountain Outdoor Activity Centre delivers enjoyable and well-organised residential trips, so I am sure the centre will provide a well-earned reward for the hard work that our pupils will have put in during their time in Year 6.

We would like to emphasise that inclusion on the trip assumes that your child is consistently well behaved throughout the school year and can demonstrate the positive values in their behaviour as promoted by the school. If their behaviour dips below what is expected regarding their behaviour score or number of incidents, your child may be removed from the trip. Unfortunately, you will not be refunded the payments that you have made. Attendance also needs to remain in line with the school target of 96%.

Please place the deposit on Arbor by the 31st October 2023 to secure your child's place for the visit. There is a maximum of 50 spaces on the trip, so places will be allocated on a first come, first served basis and **the trip will close once full** which may be before the deposit due date – please complete parental consent and payment of deposit via Arbor
