Re: Year 6 – visit to the Potteries Museum, 11th and 12th July 2024

As part of our history curriculum, we have arranged for our Year 6 pupils to visit the Potteries Museum on either 11th or 12th July 2024 depending on their class.

Pupils will have the opportunity to look at The Staffordshire Hoard and take part in a Saxon themed workshop. They will also have time to visit the Museum Shop, so a small amount of money can be brought in on the day.
