Dear Parent / Carer

Following the successes of this year's residential trips, we are delighted to announce that next year, we would like to take 50, Year 7 pupils to London. The trip will be a 4-night, 5-day residential. We will travel via coach from school to Crewe train station and then onto London on **Monday 23rd March 2026**, returning on **Friday 27th March 2026**. We will be staying at the YHA London St. Paul's, in the heart of the city.

Cost

The total cost of the trip is **£430.00** per pupil and includes:

- Travel to and from London
- Accommodation
- All meals (breakfast, lunch and evening meal)
- A full itinerary

Itinerary

We plan to visit many iconic places in London, including the London Eye, The Tower of London and many other attractions to support your child's learning.

Places available

We have 50 spaces available, due to the hostel's availability and we anticipate a very high demand. Places will be allocated on a strictly first-come, first-served basis. Pupils who are not successful in gaining a place will be put onto a waiting list.

Payment

This trip will go live on Arbor on **1st July at 7pm** and a deposit of **£100** will be required by **Sunday 31st August 2025**; once the first 50 deposits have been received, Arbor will be open in September to make as many payments as required, but the below payment schedule must be adhered to and once paid, non-refundable:

- 1. £100 to be paid by 31/08/2025**
- 2. £66 to be paid by 30/09/2025**
- 3. £66 to be paid by 31/10/2025**

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4. £66 to be paid by 30/11/2025
5. £66 to be paid by 31/01/2026
6. £66 to be paid by 28/02/2026

The school has a contract with the YHA London St. Paul's, theatre and the coach company to pay all monies due prior to the visit, so it is important that the payment plan is adhered to. Failure to meet the payment schedule could result in your child's place being allocated to a pupil on the waiting list.

Non-attendance

If for any reason your child is unable to attend, then we will be **unable to refund any monies paid**. Pupils on the waiting list will be offered any available spaces determined by their place on this list. If we are able to fill the space your child had, then we will refund monies paid, but all deposits are non-refundable.

Pupils' attendance and behaviour will be taken into consideration for this trip; **those with a cause for concern attendance record or those who cannot behave properly will not be allowed to go**. If you have any questions, then please contact the school.
