Dear Parents / Carers

As part of our commitment to providing enriching learning experiences beyond the classroom and to support our new Behaviour Curriculum, we are delighted to offer an end-of-term trip for Key Stage 3 students.

On **Friday 19<sup>th</sup> December 2025**, we are planning to take students to **CineBowl in Uttoxeter**. This trip will provide an opportunity for students to develop key personal and social skills such as teamwork, responsibility, and positive conduct in a community setting - all of which form part of our behaviour expectations.

The cost of the trip is **£21**, which covers:

- One hour of ice-skating (developing confidence, coordination and resilience)
- A film screening (promoting cultural understanding, discussion and reflection)
- Coach transport

For an **additional £5**, students may pre-order a pizza for lunch, which must be purchased separately via the school shop. Alternatively, students may bring a packed lunch from home. Those eligible for Free School Meals can request a packed lunch via the school office by Friday 12<sup>th</sup> December by emailing [hdalgleish@jamesbateman.staffs.sch.uk](mailto:hdalgleish@jamesbateman.staffs.sch.uk) stating preference of Ham, Cheese or Tuna.

The choice of film and its certification will be confirmed in due course. If you would prefer your child not to watch a film rated **12A**, then please contact the school.

Places are limited and will be offered on a first come, first served basis. The deadline for payment is **Friday 5<sup>th</sup> December 2025 at midday or when the trip is full** and payments must be made via Arbor by this date.

We will depart from school at **9:15am** and return by **3:30pm**. **School uniform is not required**.

In line with our Behaviour Curriculum, participation will be based on students demonstrating our school values both in lessons and around the school. This includes:

- Maintaining attendance in line with national expectations.
- Having no more than 20 Behaviour Points between 3<sup>rd</sup> September - 18<sup>th</sup> December 2025.
- Demonstrating consistently positive behaviour and respect for others.

Students' conduct on previous trips and during school activities will also be taken into consideration. Those who do not meet these expectations may not be eligible to attend.

As CineBowl will be exclusively hired for our school, only students attending with our staff supervision will be permitted entry.

We look forward to a fun, educational and rewarding end-of-term experience that reinforces our Behaviour Curriculum in a real-world context.
