Dear Parents/Carers,

Year 6 residential to High Borrans

The time for our residential is drawing close and we are all looking forward to having an amazing yet busy week at High Borrans. Now, may be an appropriate time to start thinking about how you can help your children prepare for their residential trip. Following the link, you will find all kit students will need and everything High Borrans will provide [Information For Parents And Carers – High Borrans](#). Students have been provided with a kit list, along with the medical form and friendship preferences list. If these can be returned as soon as possible, that would be great. If your child has misplaced or lost any of these ask them to come and see Miss Roche.

Any medication must be brought into school on the day that we leave – clearly **labelled** with the child's name and information and the dosage required. Pupils will be expected to keep their own reliever inhalers with them at all times; all other medication will be kept by staff. It is important that we are also made aware of any dietary requirements on the medical form.

Please **label all clothing** with your child's name to help us reduce the amount of lost property at the end of the week. Pupils may be required to help carry their belongings off the coaches and to their dorms, so it is important that they are packed in a way that is easy for them to manage. The dorms will have washrooms and/or en-suite bathrooms, so a towel or two will also be required.

We are requesting that no mobile phones are taken by pupils to High Borrans and those that are taken will be kept by staff until we return to school. School staff will have a full list of contacts and will contact home if necessary. Electronic games are also discouraged as we will accept no responsibility for these. We do however encourage pupils to bring along a book, magazine, pens and pencils for them to use in their free time.

On Monday 8th June, pupils will need to come to school at the normal time, dressed ready to go. Pupils will **need to bring a packed lunch**. If your child is in receipt of free school meals and wish to order one from school, you will need to order a packed lunch by emailing hdalgleish@jamesbateman.staffs.sch.uk (**please put High Borrans in the subject**) by the **15th May**. Any lunches ordered after this date will not be accepted. There will be a stop at Lancaster Services for 30 minutes on the way to High Borrans to allow pupils to eat their lunch.

We will be leaving school at approximately 11am on **Monday 8th June**. On **Friday 12th June** we will be arriving back to school at approximately 2pm, assuming no road hold ups. You will be able to collect your child at this time. We will keep you updated through Arbor and social media posts.

As would be expected, attendance on this visit is conditional upon pupils consistently meeting the school's expectations for behavior and attendance. Pupils who do not meet these expectations may not be permitted to attend.
