Dear Parent/Carer

We are now three weeks away from the final Inspire Dance Performance 2026, which will take place in the lecture theatre at Biddulph High School on Tuesday 24th March 2026.

Rehearsal Thursday 19th March 2026

A technical rehearsal will take place on Thursday 19th March where all performers will be walked to Biddulph High School for a 12pm start and back to James Bateman once the rehearsal finishes at 1.15pm (a slight change to previous timings).

Your child will need to wear their dance costume which is black leggings/trousers and a plain white t-shirt and trainers. The girls will also need a **red sequined skirt and the boys a gold baseball cap and chain** purchased from the school arbor shop.

Tickets can be purchased on arbor shop now for £6 per ticket, with a maximum of 2 tickets per child available so that capacity is not exceeded. **The deadline to buy your tickets is Wednesday 18th March 2026.** Once bought, a message will be sent out stating when tickets can be picked up from the James Bateman reception. More tickets may become available if parents do not take up their full ticket allocation. These will go on general sale at Biddulph High School where you will be able to purchase more. Please contact the High School to find out the date these go on general sale.

Show – Tuesday 24th March 2026

On the evening of Tuesday 26th March, parents will need to bring their child to Biddulph High School at 5.45pm ready in costume. Doors will open to the audience at 6pm where you will be welcomed into the refectory where they can purchase refreshments and meet friends/family and the audience will be able to use the toilets by the Lecture Theatre.

Your child will need to remain in their 'changing room' during the performance and will not be able to come out to see parents until the end of the show. The show will be live streamed into the changing room for your child to enjoy the other performances on the night.

After the show parents will be able to collect their child from the main hall and Mrs Montifroy along with other staff from James Bateman, will release your child to you once they have seen you, to ensure your child's safety.
