Dear Parents / Carers

We are delighted to invite your child to celebrate their Year 8 Leavers' Prom to honour their achievements, contributions and hard work over the past four years. The event will take place at school on **Friday 10th July 2026** with students invited to arrive from 6:30pm. The Prom will conclude at 10:00pm.

We fully appreciate that the last few years have been particularly challenging for many families, especially in terms of financial pressures. We want to reassure you that no student should feel unable to attend due to concerns regarding attire or transport. Students are welcome to attend in smart / casual dress if they prefer; of course, those whom wish to wear formal attire, or arrive in style are equally encouraged to do so. Our aim is for as many students as possible to enjoy this special evening and to celebrate their final weeks at school before moving on to high school.

Students attending the Prom will be permitted to leave school at 12:00pm on the day, allowing time to prepare and enabling staff to set up for the event; however, please note that students must attend school in the morning to be eligible to attend in the evening. Any student who does not attend school that morning will not be permitted to return for the Prom.

Attendance and behaviour will be closely monitored in the lead-up to the event. Students with a cause for concern attendance record, or those who accrue more than 10 Behaviour Points from 1st June 2026 onwards, or are subject to any serious behaviour incidents or fixed-term exclusions, may not be eligible to attend. Please be aware that if a student becomes ineligible to attend under these criteria, any payment made will be non-refundable.

We sincerely hope to see as many of our Year 8 students as possible at the Prom and to give them a memorable send-off. The cost of the event is **£16** which includes food and entertainment. Payment should be made via Arbor by **Friday 3rd July 2026**.
