Dear Parent/Guardian,

Year 5 Visit to The Staffordshire Regiment Museum

As part of our summer topic, World War II, we have organised a trip for Year 5 pupils to visit The Staffordshire Regiment Museum. The pupils will be given the opportunity to fully immerse themselves in what life would have been like during WW2 as they experience the sights and sounds of WW2 through hands on activities and demonstrations. These trips will be taking place on the Tuesday 23rd June and Wednesday 24th June.

Please ensure you arrive at school for **8:15am** as we will be leaving at **8:30am** prompt. We plan to arrive back by the end of the school day, however if there are any changes to this on the day we will keep you informed.

- **5SLF & 5BES – Tuesday 23rd June 2026**
- **5RJ & 5RB – Wednesday 24th June 2026**

This is a fully funded trip so the expectation is that ALL pupils will attend, however parents/carers must give permission on Arbor. Pupils will need to ensure they bring a packed lunch. If your child is in receipt of Free School Meals a packed lunch may be ordered by emailing hdalgleish@jamesbateman.staffs.sch.uk, please put STAFFORDHIRE REGIMENT MUSEUM in the subject line and let us know whether your child will want ham, cheese or tuna sandwiches. The **closing date** for this trip is **Friday 12TH June 2026**. If you choose to send in your own packed lunch, please ensure it is in a labelled carrier bag which can be thrown away afterwards (so pupils do not have to carry boxes, bags or flasks for the duration of the day).

We are encouraging pupils to dress up as an evacuee/wartime child in order to fully experience what life would have been like for children of their age during WWII. Although fancy dress would be great if possible, it will not be compulsory and children who will not be dressing up are to wear full school uniform.

Behavior and attendance will be closely monitored prior to the trip. Should a pupil's behavior or attendance cause us concern then their place on the trip may be challenged. We will keep you informed if this is the case. If there are any further queries regarding this visit, please do not hesitate to get in touch with school.
