Dear Parents /Carers

A visit has been arranged for all Year 7 pupils to visit the British Ironwork Centre – this will link in with Science, Technology, Maths and PSHE. 7CMo and 7FC will go on **Thursday 7th May** and 7SC and 7LC will go on **Friday 8th May**. Coaches will leave school at 9:00am and will return at approximately 3.30pm; this will ensure pupils have a full day to enjoy all the activities that the centre has to offer! The day will include visiting the various sculptures, walking round the trails examining the craft work and completing the extinction trail.

As we feel it is important for every pupil to take part, the cost of this visit will be fully subsidised by the school and not asking parents to make any payment at all. Consent will need to be made before the trip takes place and can be done via Arbor under trips.

Pupils may take spending money for the day as there are things to spend money on such as ice creams and a gift shop to visit if they wish (recommendation of no more than £15).
